# **Upgrade to Chatswood High School**

## Works notification

September 2022

### Removal of demountable classrooms at Chatswood High School

Construction of Building S at the high school and Buildings P1 and P2 at the public school is nearing completion. The new teaching spaces will be handed over to the schools in December 2022, ready to welcome students from Day 1 Term 1 2023.

Between 21 December 2021 and 25 January 2022, 62 demountable classrooms will be dismantled and removed from their location around the northern, southern and western perimeter of the oval and to the east of Building R at the Chatswood High School. A map is provided overleaf. The timing of the work will be weather dependant and we do not expect this work to be noisy.

The demountable classrooms currently occupying the high school staff car park will remain in place until the completion of Buildings Q and T in the second half of 2023.

The Bush Campus to the east of the oval will be retained as contingency for future enrolment increases.

### Demountable removal activity

The work will take place during the summer school holidays to limit impact on school operations and will be staged to reduce disruption to traffic in the local area. It will take place within approved construction work hours which are Monday to Friday 7am to 6pm, Saturday 8am – 4pm.

Activity	Timeframe	Detail
Relocation	2 December – 20 December 2022	Relocation of teaching materials and equipment into Buildings S, P1 and P2.
Disconnection	From 15 December 2022	As demountable classrooms are emptied, AV equipment and amenities will be disconnected and relocated
Dismantle and removal	21 December 2022 – 25 January 2023	Demountable classrooms and walkways will be dismantled on site and moved via crane onto flatbed trucks
New power supply for Bush Campus	12 January 2023 – 20 January 2023	New trenching will be built to connect the power supply from Building M to the Bush Campus


### Access to site and traffic controls

The oversized flatbed trucks will start to arrive prior to 7am and we expect there to be an average of 20 truck movements per day. They will enter and exit the site primarily through the existing oval entrance on Eddy Road. There will be a small number of demountable classrooms removed via Oliver Road between 21 and 28 December, and the drop off zone on Oliver Road will be temporarily closed throughout the school holidays.

Local roads and footpaths will remain open with traffic controls in place to ensure the safety of road users and pedestrians.

### Access to facilities

Due to the nature of the work, including the need for the crane to slew across the oval, it will be closed from 21 December 2022 to 26 January 2023. There will be no community access to the oval during this time. We have engaged Polytan, the company which installed the oval's artificial surface, to provide appropriate protective measures for the oval, which will be reinstated to the standard that it was before the works started.


The Bush Campus will lose power between 21 December 2022 and 20 January 2023 and will be unavailable for school holiday activities.

Following the removal of the demountable classrooms, the oval will be reopened for use and a new public access pathway to the oval will be available from Oliver Road. During Term 1 2023, work will start to remediate the sports courts and cricket nets. These facilities will be available for use by the school and local communities by Day 1 Term 2 2023.

We have worked closely with both school principals to minimise disruption to students and staff and are continuing to liaise with Willoughby Council as the coordinator of community sporting groups.
