Chatswood Public School and Chatswood High School Works lookahead - October 2022

Investing in our schools

The NSW Government is investing \$8.6 billion in school infrastructure over the next four years, continuing its program to deliver 160 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. This builds on the more than \$9.1 billion invested in projects delivered since 2017, a program of \$17.7 billion in public education infrastructure.

The NSW Department of Education is committed to delivering new and upgraded schools for communities across NSW. The delivery of these important projects is essential to the future learning needs of our students and supports growth in the local economy.

Next steps

The Chatswood Schools project is nearing the exciting milestones of handing over Building S at the high school and Buildings P1 and P2 at the public school towards the end of Term 4.

Activity at both sites has reached a point where scaffolding is now either fully stripped or starting to come down as cladding and external finishes are finalised. Internal services installations and finishes such as painting, flooring and joinery are continuing, and during October landscaping works will start at both schools, weather dependent

To minimise impact to school operations, the project team will be working during the upcoming school holiday period to undertake utility works at both sites (communications, electrical and stormwater). They will also undertake rectification works at Building R at the high school, and the sports court at the public school. The public school will also have new wider access pathways from Pacific Highway when students return for the start of Term 4.

The planned activities for the holiday period and for the month of October is provided for each school overleaf.

During construction, access to buildings and driveways will be maintained at all times. Where temporary footpath changes, car parking removal or lane closures are required for works, traffic control, pedestrian detours, and signage will be in place to assist the community.

Some of this work may be noisy; however, we will take every possible step to minimise noise, such as switching off equipment when not in use and using non-tonal reversing beepers.

Standard construction hours for this project are 7 am to 6 pm Mondays to Fridays, and 8 am to 4 pm, Saturdays. No works will take place on Sundays or public holidays, unless otherwise notified.
