GRADE SPORT INFORMATION & PERMISSION NOTE 2020

Grade/Rec Sport will be conducted on Thursday afternoons from 12:00 - 2:30pm for students in Yrs 8-12. It gives all students the opportunity to participate in competitive sport against other schools across Ku-ring Gai Zone, or recreational sport on a weekly basis. A variety of sports are available for students to participate in over 3 seasons: Summer, Winter and Spring.

Students are able to choose a different sport each season using our online selection system. Trials will be held at school for the first 2 weeks of each new season to select teams.

Grade Sport

Grade sport incurs a cost for the bus for AWAY or CENTRAL VENUE sports (Central venue sports include basketball, table tennis and badminton). Students are expected to pay this bus fee in full at the beginning of each season. A payment slip for the grade sport bus fee is attached to the bottom of this permission note. Any student who has not paid this fee at the commencement of the grade sport season will **NOT** be allowed to attend Grade Sport and will be expected to attend Non-Sport for the afternoon.

If students are unable to participate in sport due to sickness or injury, they must show a **signed note** by their parent/guardian to the Sports Organiser in the PDHPE staffroom. This must be completed **before school OR at recess ONLY** on the day. These students will be placed on the Non-Sport roll and will be expected to attend Non-Sport. Students may use this time to complete homework, assignments and engage in personal study. Thursday afternoons (Grade/Rec sport time) should not be used as a time to make appointments. It is preferable that appointments are made out of school time or at a variety of different times during the week, rather than consistently during Thursday afternoon sport. Any student wishing to sign out must get approval from the Sports Organiser first, and then sign out as usual at the front office.

All students are expected to be in full Chatswood HS sport uniform every Thursday. Students wear their sport uniform for the whole day. Students who do not wear full CHS sport uniform, bring their money, or truant will be given appropriate discipline by their sport teacher including lunch detentions, parental contact etc. If this behaviour becomes persistent, they will be referred to the Sports Organizer who will process an "Unsatisfactory Letter" to be sent home, will be given an after school detention and will be expected to attend Sport Detention for a designated period of time.

- 5. It is the responsibility of the student to ensure they have had their named marked off at the beginning and end of sport. Failure to do so will result in a formal letter being sent home, along with an after school detention and a phone call to parents/ guardians from the sports organiser.
- 6. Grade sports requires a payment for the buses. Students will not be able to participate in grade sport until this fee is paid.
