Upgrades to Chatswood Public School and Chatswood High School

Project overview

The Department of Education is upgrading Chatswood Public School and Chatswood High School.

With a growing reputation for educational excellence, both schools have seen significant enrolment growth exceeding predicted current and future capacity, with resulting pressure on available space and facilities at each school. Across the two schools, the upgrades will support high-quality educational outcomes to meet the needs of students within the local community.

The State Significant Development (SSD) application for this redevelopment was lodged with the Department of Planning, Industry and Environment (DPIE) in March 2020.

The project team is awaiting determination and anticipate an outcome in early 2021. Separate to these main works, a new builidng (Building R) at Chatswood High School will be built as complying development to support the staged delivery of the upgrades and minimise impacts to school

Richard Crookes Construction has been awarded the design and construction contract to complete the design of the new facilities and construct Building R.

The anticipated project completion date is the end of 2023.

Staged delivery

The project team has developed a proposed staging plan in consultation with the school principals and construction contractor. The proposed plan minimises disruption, priorities safety and amenity, and maximises outdoor play space for students. Further information about the changes for each year group will be provided by each school towards the end of Term 4.

Chatswood Public School

Chatswood Public School is currently in a campus configuration with Years K-2 and Years 5-6 located on the Pacific Highway campus, and Years 3 and 4 on the 'Bush Campus' on the grounds of Chatswood High School.

During construction, Chatswood Public School will continue to operate across both the Pacific Highway and Bush Campus, with the number of students located at the Bush Campus temporarily increasing.

From Day 1 Term 1 2021, Years 3-6 will be located on the Pacific Highway Campus, and Years K-2 and the Multi-Categorical Support Unit will be located on the Bush Campus.

Chatswood High School

Chatswood High School students will be accommodated at the High School in a combination of demountable classrooms and existing buildings until project completion. The location of the High School demountables is shown in the maps overleaf.

Access changes

While construction is underway, some access points will change:

- The High School staff car park off De Villiers Avenue will be unavailable until late 2022
- The existing stairs from Centennial Avenue to the Bush Campus and oval will be altered to include a temporary walkway. The walkway will create a bridge over the Oliver Road entrance to provide safe and continued access to the Bush Campus and oval while trucks are moving to and from the Building R construction zone.
- While the walkway bridge over the Oliver Road entrance is being constructed, the Bush Campus will be accessible from Freeman Road and at times Eddy Road, and community access to the oval will be from Eddy Road
- The Oliver Road school entry will be unavailable from late 2020 until late 2021.

Operational impacts

- Outside of school hours care will be relocated to classrooms, more information will be provided to families in Term 4 2020
- School pick up and drop off locations may change following advice from the principals
- High School construction access will be from Oliver Road, De Villiers Avenue and Centennial Avenue outside of school peak pick up and drop off times. Eddy Road will also be used during the installation of demountables
- Public School construction access will be from the Pacific Highway and Jenkins Street

- Traffic conditions will change at specific times due to the nature of the work. Traffic controllers will be in place where required.
- Sections of the High School oval will be unavailable for use on specified crane use days until early 2021. Council and the school communities will be notified in advance when the oval will be unavailable.

Staging activities schedule

Staging activities from late 2020 through to project completion include:

- 1. Enabling works (to prepare the sites for construction)
- 2. Construction works.

Enabling works started in the October school holidays and will continue until early 2021. Construction of the new Building R at Chatswood High School is scheduled to start in late 2020, pending receipt of the complying development certificate. Construction will not start on the main works until the outcome of the State Significant Development application is known.



Chatswood High School

- Installation of demountables on the High School staff car park, sports courts, cricket nets and near the Bush Campus for Public School and High School use during Term 4 2020
- Minor landscaping to the north of the future Building R compound and to the east of the Bush Campus during Term 4 2020
- Site investigations including geotech drilling and hazardous materials testing started during the Term 3 holidays and will continue outside of school hours in Term 4 2020
- Teaching materials in Buildings C, D and E will be relocated into the newly installed demountables on the car park, sports court and cricket nets during Term 4 2020 and over the 20/21 summer break
- Commence construction of Building R.

Chatswood Public School

- Site investigations including geotech drilling and hazardous materials testing started during the Term 3 holidays and will continue outside of school hours in Term 4 2020
- Teaching materials in the existing Public School demountables will be relocated into the newly installed demountables near the Bush Campus in early 2021
- Removal of demountable classroms from the Pacific Highway in early 2021.




