

Upgrades to Chatswood Public School and Chatswood High School

Works notification

February 2021

The NSW Government is upgrading Chatswood Public School and Chatswood High School with new and improved education facilities to support the student community.

Tower crane installation

On Saturday 20 February between 7:00am and 5:00pm, a tower crane will be installed at Chatswood High School on the Building R construction site, weather permitting (see map). Construction traffic will enter the school through the Oliver Road entrance and traffic control will be in place.

The tower crane will assist with the movement of materials on site.

Appropriate controls and monitoring measures will operate while the crane is on site. Crane loads are restricted to lifting within the perimeter of the construction site and no loads will be lifted over school buildings, play areas, residential buildings or public areas.

When not in use the crane will operate in 'free slew', which is a safety measure that allows it to move freely in the wind when not in use. The location of the crane has been selected to ensure a 360-degree clearing around the arm. The crane installation will be signed off by a Structural Engineer ahead of works being undertaken, and will be subject to daily pre-start inspections prior to operation.

Demountable works

As previously notified, demountable classrooms are being installed at Chatswood High School to accommodate students during construction.

On Saturday 20 February between 7:00am and 5:00pm, demountable classrooms are scheduled to be installed to the south of the oval, weather permitting.

The demountable classrooms will be transported by truck to Chatswood High School and enter the school through the Eddy Road entrance. Traffic control will be in place.

There will be no access to the oval through the Eddy Road vehicle entrance on Saturday 20 February only, with access instead through the pedestrian entry on Eddy Road and via Centennial Avenue (see map).

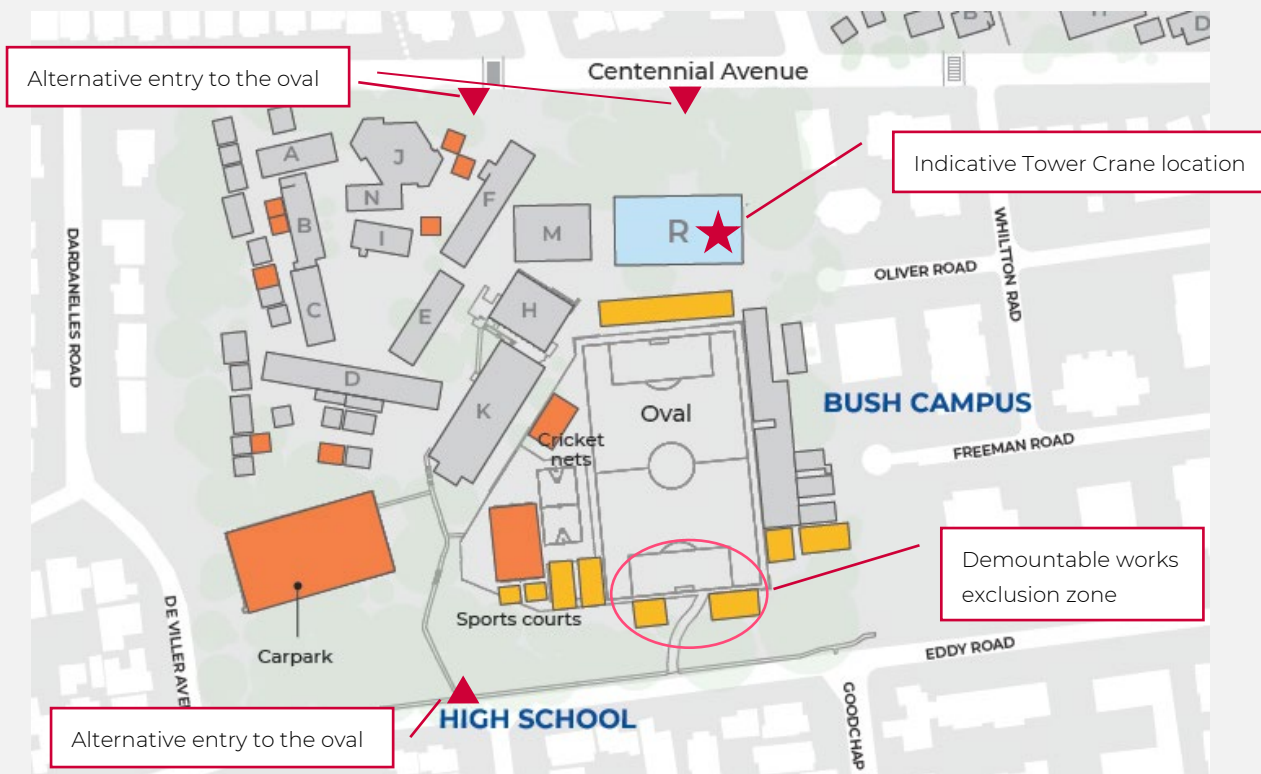
To ensure the safety of community users, an exclusion zone will be set up on the southern section of the oval on Friday 19 February to support the installation works (see map). The exclusion zone will take up approximately one third of the southern half of the oval. Sporting activities on the oval will be impacted between 7:00am to 5:00pm on Saturday 20 February.

The exclusion zone will be removed before school resumes on Monday 22 February. A small section of fencing will remain on the oval until installation work is completed later in Term 1.
