


Student survey results – August 2021



These are very early responses with the survey closing Sunday afternoon. We will break the results down into years once the survey closes.








The students indicating that they are having difficulties with technology will need to be identified and assisted.

My teachers plan interesting class activities and give thorough explanations of what is required.



My teachers provide work that is challenging but achievable.












The amount of work my teachers expect me to complete is just right.



The individual responses written in text at the end of the survey indicate that the students feel that there is too much work.




This is a very positive reflection point for the teaching staff.




After five weeks of remote learning this is a positive indicator but we will need to return to this question again.
